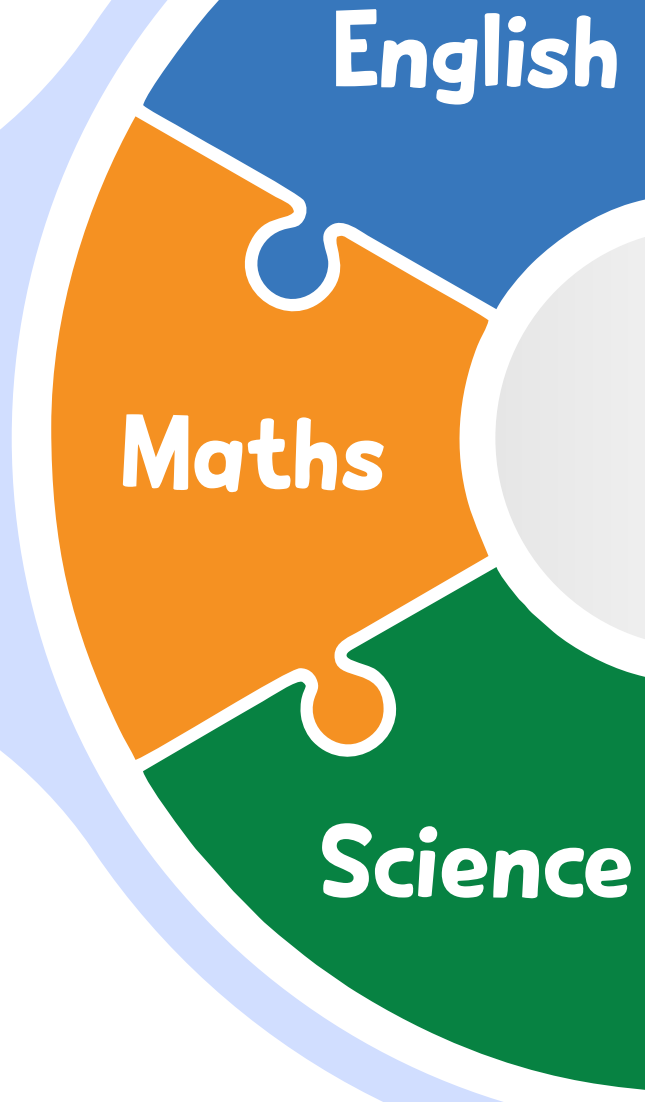

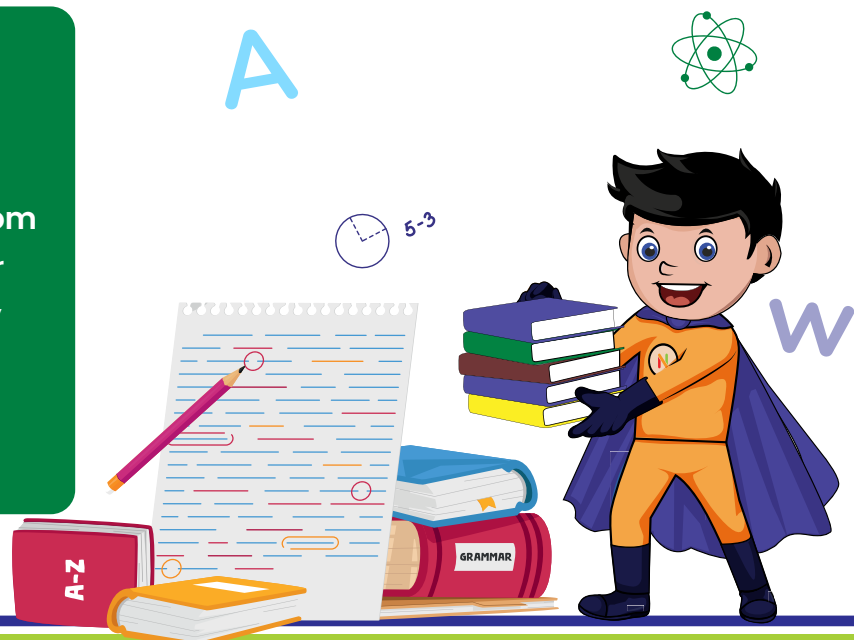

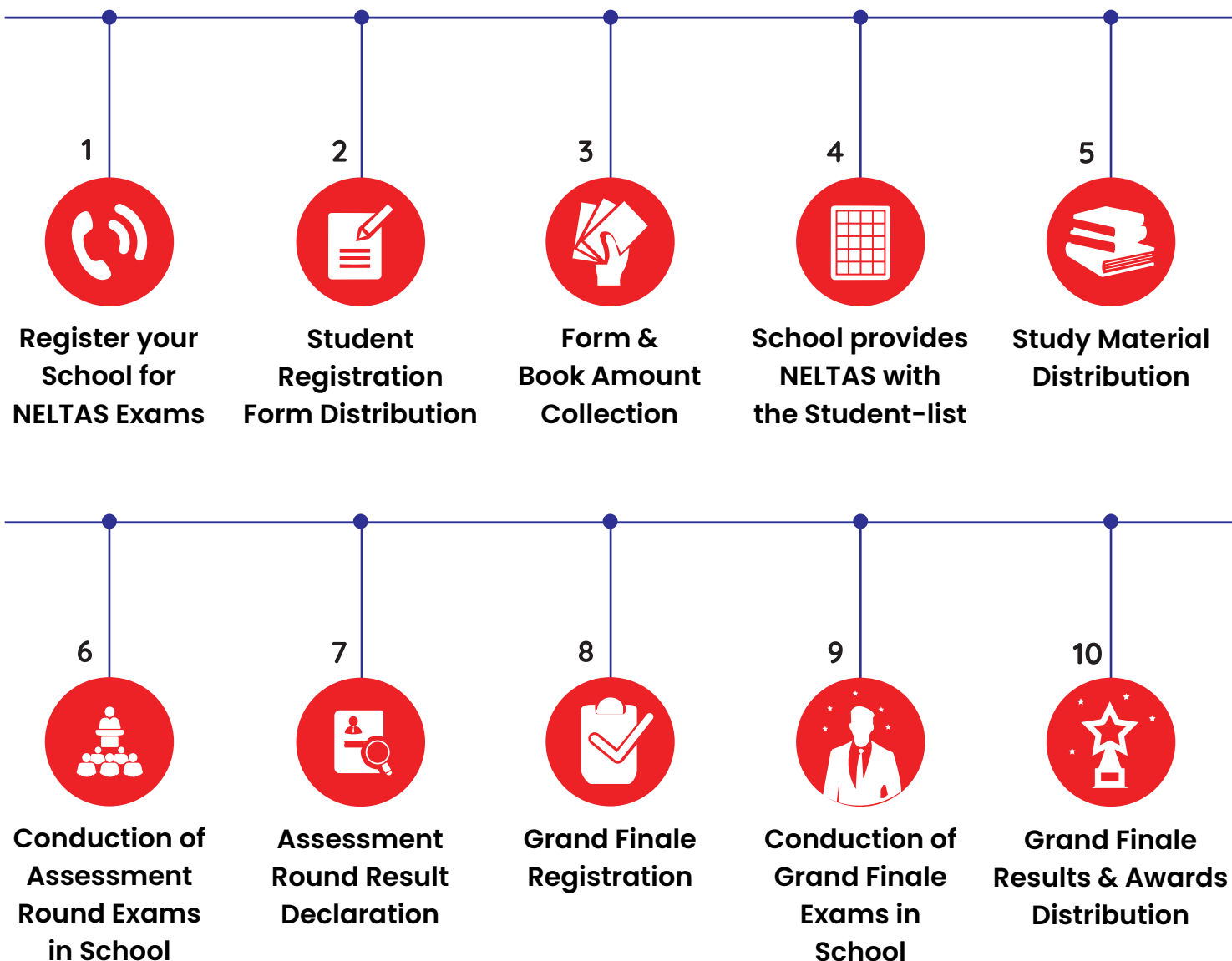
1 ASSESSMENT ROUND

Identifying the theme or purpose of the passage: This skill is based on Reading Comprehension, it helps us to know whether you are able to exactly point out a certain statement or issue as the central idea of a passage, story, report or a poem. Identifying the theme is your strength. You have been clever enough and have exercised accurate judgment in identifying the theme.

Inferring and Identifying implied ideas: Many a times ideas and thoughts are not explicitly stated. There may be certain hints in a passage leading to a certain idea which is not directly given in the passage. You were smart enough to infer and identify such implied ideas.

Reasoning ability and Deducing: Reasoning ability, as the name suggests tests your ability to reason and arrive at a logical conclusion and inferences that are also in cohesion with the ideas in a passage. It is a very good ability in you and you have answered almost all questions based on this skill correctly.

Extracting information and direct facts: This skill tests whether the child can pin point exact details and information from different media such as reports, advertisements, comic strips, etc. This skill is your strength and you have exhibited intelligence and have successfully been able to answer questions based on this skill correctly.

Punctuation and Sentence formation: Though punctuation may seem a minor grammar concept, it's unsuitable use or lack of it's usage can totally transform the meaning of a sentence or an idea. You are well aware of the usage of punctuation symbol and can also restructure sentences that are incorrectly framed.

Your Areas of Improvement:

Word building and Spelling: This skill deals with a student's ability to scramble, unscramble, create, modify spellings and words and make anagrams. You require more practice to master this skill.

Vocabulary in different context: This skill not just tests how vast your vocabulary is but also helps us determine how effectively you use the same word differently. You have also been unable to understand other aspects associated with a particular word. You should work on expanding your vocabulary.

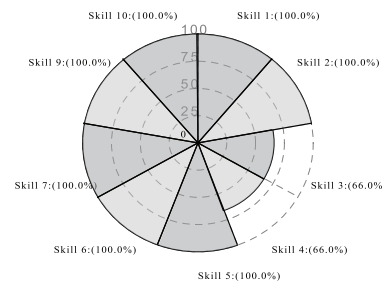

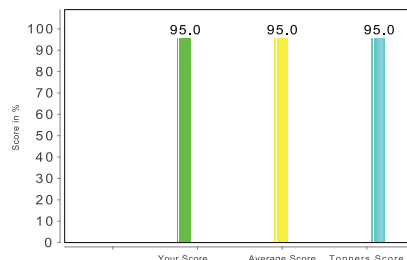
