**Word building and Spelling:** This skill deals with a student's ability to scramble, unscramble, create, modify spellings and words and make anagrams. You require more practice to master this skill.

**Identifying the theme or purpose of the passage:** This skill is based on Reading Comprehension, it helps us to know whether you are able to exactly point out a certain statement or issue as the central idea of a passage , story, report or a poem. You seem to have missed the point and have not exercised accurate judgment in identifying the theme.

**Inferring and Identifying implied ideas:** Many a times ideas and thoughts are not explicitly stated. There may be certain hints in a passage leading to a certain idea which is not directly given in the passage. Unfortunately, you were not able to infer and identify such implied ideas. You must practice reading and at the same time understanding the passage to extract such ideas.

**Extracting information and direct facts:** This skill tests whether the child can pin point exact details and information from different media such as reports, advertisements, comic strips, etc. Though you are aware of the general idea in a passage, you need to be more precise when extracting information and certain specific details.

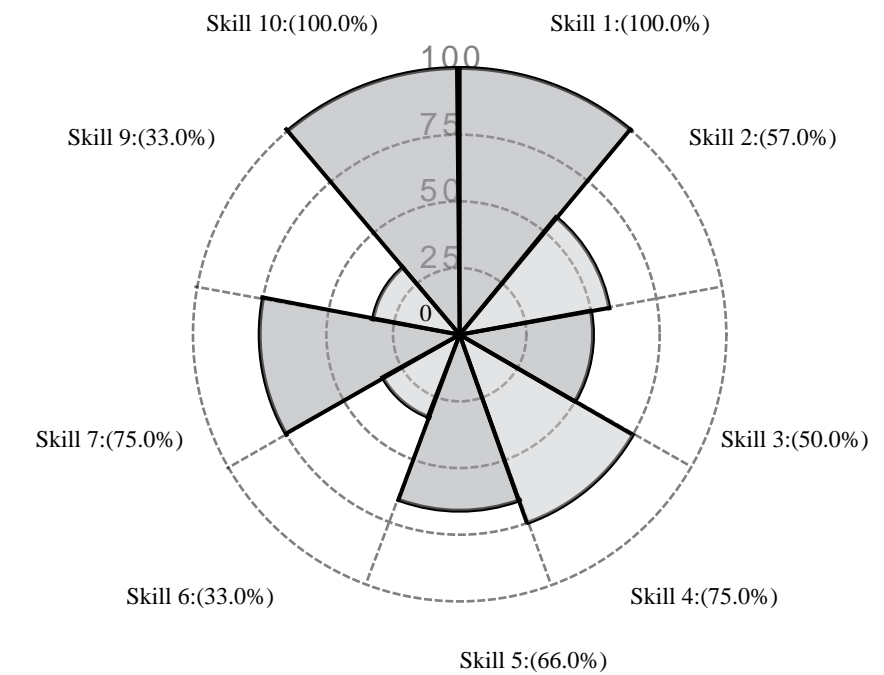

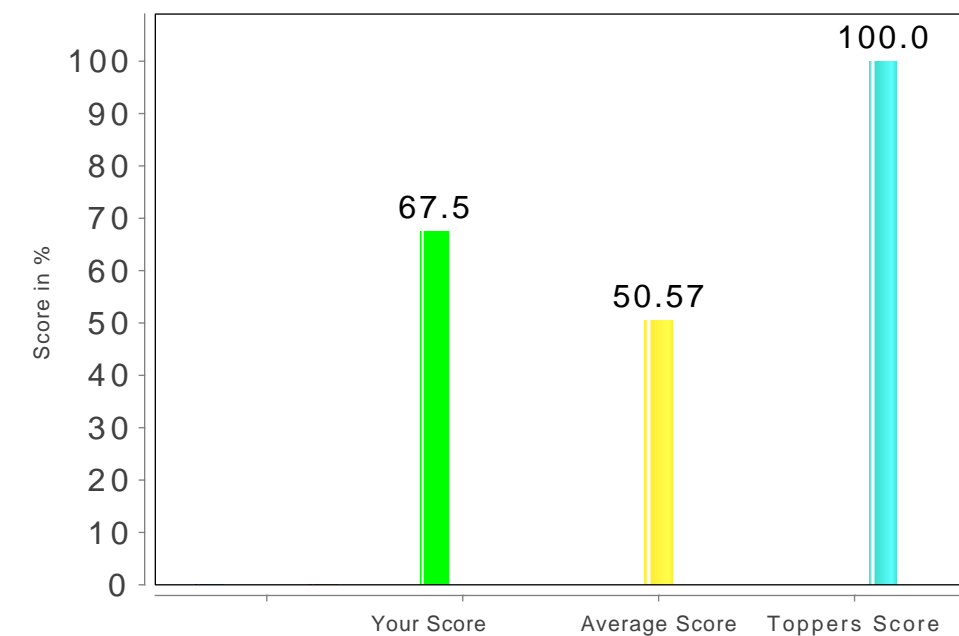
