Your Strengths:

Application of Functional Grammar: This skill tests the student's knowledge of functional grammar and their ability to apply it in various situations. Extracting information and direct facts: This skill tests whether the child can pin point exact details and information from different media such as reports, advertisements, comic strips, etc. This skill is your strength and you have exhibited intelligence and have successfully been able to answer questions based on this skill correctly.

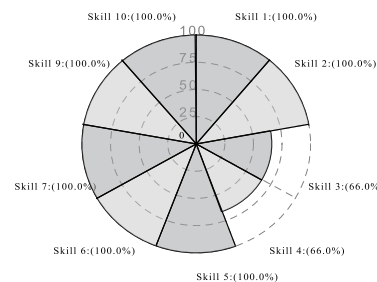

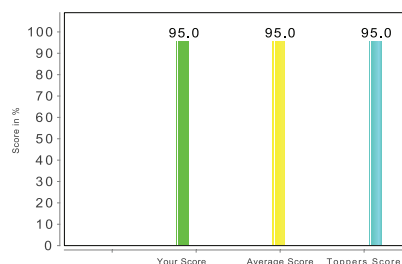
